Conditions:

- *FCRA Certificate:* The Institution must submit AKKA a copy of the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) certificate issued by the Government of India before the funds are released. A copy of FCRA certificate must be mailed to the address as given in the "AKKA Contact Information" paragraph.
- *Progress Report:* The Institution must provide AKKA a one page report including pictures on the progress of the project on a monthly basis. This report must be e-mailed to the contact person as specified in the "AKKA Contact Information" paragraph. In addition to this, AKKA may get its own report on the project from time to time through personal visits or through local contacts.
- *Funds Cancellation:* AKKA reserves the right to cancel project funding if the allocated funds are not used for the specified tasks as mentioned in the "Funds Usage" paragraph at the location mentioned in the "Project Location". In case of funds cancellation, the Institution must pay back AKKA the entire amount within 90 days of cancellation.
- *Project Dedication:* The Institution must inform AKKA once the project is completed. The Institution must also invite AKKA members for any dedication ceremony. The Institution must also accommodate for permanent placement of AKKA name or plaque wherever applicable. Examples include AKKA seal on Books, AKKA logo on the Building, etc.
- *Publicity Rights:* AKKA can use any or all of the project information (pictures, video, text, etc.) for publicizing the charitable work it is supporting.
- *Liability:* AKKA is not responsible for any damages to property or injuries caused to individuals beginning, during or after the project.
- *Conflict of Interest:* The Institution shall not involve in any activities that will conflict with the objectives of AKKA as defined in the AKKA Constitution on AKKA website, resulting which may lead to cancellation of the funds.
